Long weekend away from Sydney in Timor Leste. Great challenges, but great time . . . **4W3A**. Nice to see 10m open . . . **4X6DK**. Thanks to CN8WK and CN8WW . . . **5D5A**. It could have been better, but just came home after a long trip. But some QSOs got in my log . . . **5P1B**. 2-el Yagi for 10-15-20, dipole for 40-80-160. Very 73 de 5P3WW Crew . . . **5P3WW**. Mini-DXpedition to Roemoe Island, EU-125. Operated only 27 hours using this brand new call sign due to family obligations. Nice to see the sunspots back! Station: FT-857, ALS-500 running 500W, triband vertical for 10/15/20m and dipole for 40/80m . . . **5P5K**. Doing the contest was so much fun. 10 hours entering the paper log into the PC was Not! LOL. Thanks guys for a wonderful contest . . . **6Y1X**. K3 Elecraft, 5 Watts, dipole 10mh . . . **7K1CPT**. I was able to enjoy this contest. Tnx for a fine contest again. IC-7600, dipole . . . **7N2UQC**. Not big score but enjoyed much! . . . **7N4CPT**. IC-718, antenna dipole, 18m up, 80-100W, . . . **9A1JSB**. Most of the antennas on 9A8M team location are down for fixing, so took my first shot at SOSB category. Good conditions, went to sleep too early first evening. FT1000, OMPower, KT34A on 16m (rotated by hand) . . . **9A5ADT**. Wow! What a contest. 15 meters was really cooking. it stayed opened almost around midnight local time. Fun contest. First one ever for me . . . **AG6AZ**. Fun condx on 10. First WPX! . . . **AH6KW**. Trying to break the Oceania 10 meter Assisted record . . . **AH6RR**. ContestPediton to Hawaii. Thanks for the use of your FB station Max (KH6ZM) . . . **AH7NA**. Two ops, but only one operating at a time . . . **AK1W**. Icom 7000, Inv Vee DP @ 4mh. Many thanks to all! CU AGN 73! . . . **BA1SN**. Was stationless until around 09:00 GMT when I discovered that 5B4ES was not being used by anyone! I decided to try a SB entry on 10m. Some weird propagation to Pacific, Asia, SA, and western Europe. No east or central EU propagation. Good fun! . . . **C4W**. Too many bad and wide sigs from EU made it tough for low power stns. Either could not hear or get through to many top tier let alone 2nd tier US stns due to the noise of bad operators. Cndx for 15mtrs is on the up but not there yet, great for equatorial regions but fade-outs for those of us at more northerly latitudes. It was so nice to work S&P with lots of mults and the simple antennas worked quit good. It was nice to see how some weak DX were able to copy and work me, while some others "krokodiles in splatter mode" just could not hear me.
